

# AFTER ACTION REPORTS: CL#39

## **CAPTAIN'S LOG #39 AFTER ACTION REPORT**

Page #37: Rule (4YJ2e) says that plasma-F torpedoes "operate as other torpedoes with the first turn of arming energy applied by emptying the batteries." At the start of a scenario, plasma torpedoes get their first turn of arming free (4J2e), so the text ". . . by emptying the batteries." Should be deleted.

Page #38: Rule (7YG): The "PCW" does not mean a PC with a web caster, but the standard configuration in *Star Fleet Battles* with web generators in place of the phaser-3s found on the improved patrol corvette.

Page #49: (SL280.63) The objective of the Iridani force is to prevent the Banshees from reaching the planet.

Page #68: The text in (U6.0) should say "This event happened long *before* . . .".

Page #117: The SSD for the Federation Squadron Scale Early Heavy Cruiser, is listed as having 24 boxes; this is the correct number. The shield has two boxes too many, i.e., 26.

## **CAPTAIN'S LOG #39 LARGE PRINT EDITION**

Page #53 of the large print edition: Rule (4YJ2e) says that plasma-F torpedoes "operate as other torpedoes with the first turn of arming energy applied by emptying the batteries." At the start of a scenario, plasma torpedoes get their first turn of arming free (4J2e), so the text ". . . by emptying the batteries." Should be deleted.

Page #54 of the large print edition: Rule (7YG) was cut off. The missing text after ". . . but the existing patrol corvette (PC, PCW) and" is ". . . the Neo-Tholian destroyer (NDD) and frigate (NFF) were available in the Early Years. Because of their extra-galactic origins, these ships, while small, do NOT use the Early Years rules". The "PCW" does not mean a PC with a web caster, but the standard configuration in *Star Fleet Battles* with web generators in place of the phaser-3s found on the improved patrol corvette.

Page #54 of the large print edition: Rule (7YL) was omitted: The Early Heavy Cruiser is a well-rounded example of Early Years technology, more than able to hold its own against any of its possible opposition.

Page #54 of the large print edition: There is text missing after the above Lyran rule. The Paravian and Carnivon empires mentioned in the rules text were extinct long before the General War. The Gorns accidentally wiped out the Paravians, and the Lyrans and Kzintis (felines) deliberately wiped out the Carnivons (wolves).

Page #92 of the large print version: At the tail end of (U2.22), right before the (U3.0) section, there are some horizontal lines that do not belong. One goes through the text on the second line (" . . . the Early Warp ships . . ."); one goes through the fourth line (" . . . a Destroyer . . ."). The text is readable. We are not sure what caused this. The lines are apparently dividing lines that were put in to make reading the ship selections in (U2.22) easier in the 9-point print editions (and were deleted in the 10-point edition) that somehow drifted rather than being deleted.

Page #95 of the large print version: The text in (U6.0) should say "This event happened long *before* . . .".

Page #157: The SSD for the Federation Squadron Scale Early Heavy Cruiser, is listed as having 24 boxes; this is the correct number. The shield has two boxes too many, i.e., 26.

Page #9: The *Captain's Log #38* errata in some of the earliest printings of this supplement included an error of its own, further compounding the error it was meant to correct. The line item "Page #94: (6AA3) Turn #8 should read: "the Lyrans should be listed as able to put fighters on their bases from this point on. They cannot build carriers during the scenario."

Page #11: Hydran Master Fighter Annex Extract: Some of the earliest printings of this supplement incorrectly listed the Stinger-2p (and the mega-packed version Stinger-2pM). These fighters were in the Master Fighter Chart in *Module G3*. These fighters should have been the Stinger-P and Stinger-PM, this was corrected in later printings. The data for the two fighters is repeated here.

ST-P, 1, 15, 1xPh-G-FA, 1xPh-2-FA, -, 10, -, 10, 175, 3, CL#21

ST-PM, 1, 30, 1xPh-G-FA, 1xPh-2-FA, 1xPh-3-FA, -, 10, -, 179, 1, CL#21.

Page #13: Under plasma-V torpedoes the correct listing for the Veltressaian home planet should have been Veltressa.

Page #15: Under plasma blasters the Korlivalar home planet should have been Korlivala. Under plasma cannons the correct listing for the Rovillian home planet should have been Rovilla. Under plasma vortex launchers the correct listing for the Pronhoulite home planet should have been Pronhoula.
