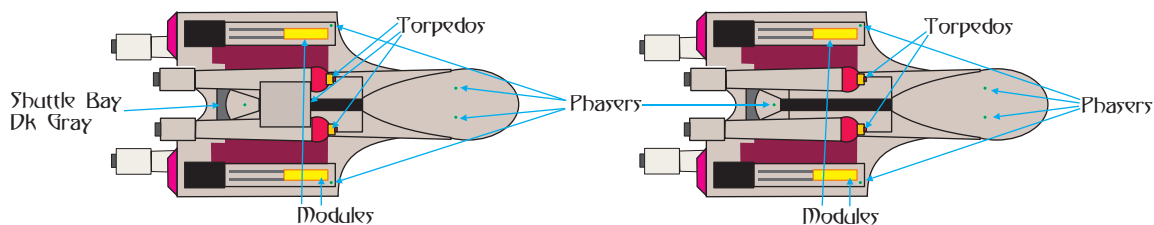
Sparrowhawk

Decals come clear coated with Microscale Decal Saver. Miniatures should be painted with gloss paint for excellent decal results. Testors Dullcote or Polly Scale Clear Flat or Semi-Gloss is recommended to "blend in" the decals with the Finish. Wipe decals off after drying to remove any adhesive remaining after the decal has dried. This prevents decals from yellowing with time.

Painting Tips: Use Tamiya White Spray Primer for base coat. This is by far the best primer to use. It covers well, has an ultra fine pigment, and doesn't pebble like other brands. Use a good spray Lacquer like Tamiya or an automotive type for good durable paint. Use acrylics for detail painting. Poly Scale is a good choice with lots of grays for detailing. The Last Detail Black Wash is the last step. Let it flow into the recessed areas like shield grids and vents. Wipe off with a damp Cotton swab. Seal it all with a nice semi-gloss clearcoat to protect the finish.
