

AFTER ACTION REPORTS: SFB MODULE G3A

Page #38 (R2.24) Police Carrier (PV): The notes following the table were accidentally switched from *Module J*. The † note should apply to the *Marshall*, the ‡ note should apply to *Sheriff*.

Page #40 (R2.75) Battle Control Ship (BCS): This ship should have noted that it has one internal shuttle bay, which operates normally, and the bay used by the heavy fighters is semi-external. All six heavy fighters can be launched or landed (or some could be landing while others launch) in a single impulse or over multiple impulses. Mines can only be laid from the internal shuttle bay (M2.113).

Page #100: SH161 title misspelled in scenario rule number index. "Poessionion" should be "Possession".

Page #105: SL258 title misspelled in scenario rule number index. "But Raid" should be "Bug Raid".

Page #105: There are two listings for SL223 and SL224 in the rule number index with slightly different data. Steve Petrick was probably interrupted (for any of a number or reasons) while entering the *CL#27* information.

Pages #110, #112 and #114: "Chronological" is misspelled as "Chornological" in the page header.

Page #110: There are two listings for SL224 in the Chronological index with different slightly data. Steve Petrick was probably interrupted (for any of a number or reasons) while entering the *CL#27* information.

Pages #111 through #114: Some of the first copies apparently escaped from the ADB, Inc., building with the new heading superimposed over the old heading on Pages #111 through #114. We caught this error at the very last minute, just after printing had begun, and thought we had replaced all of the bad pages before the first book was bound, but apparently we missed at least one. While it looks bad, at least it does not interfere with any of the data in the tables.

Page #114: There are two listings for SL223 in the Chronological index with different slightly data. Steve Petrick was probably interrupted (for any of a number or reasons) while entering the *CL#27* information.

Page #114: SH161 title misspelled in the scenario chronological index. "Poessionion" should be "Possession".

It was asked why many of the Hydran fighters in Annex #4 Master Fighter Chart did not show the "r" refit. The "r" refit showed up in Y180, by which time the only one of the variant Stinger-2s that reached operational deployment was out of service. (The Stinger-2P was in squadron service in Y175 and withdrawn from service in Y177.) As such, the "r" refit was applied only to those fighters in general service in Y180, and was cancelled the same year (with, as the history noted, a major investigation into the Hydran Kingdom's fighter procurement system).
